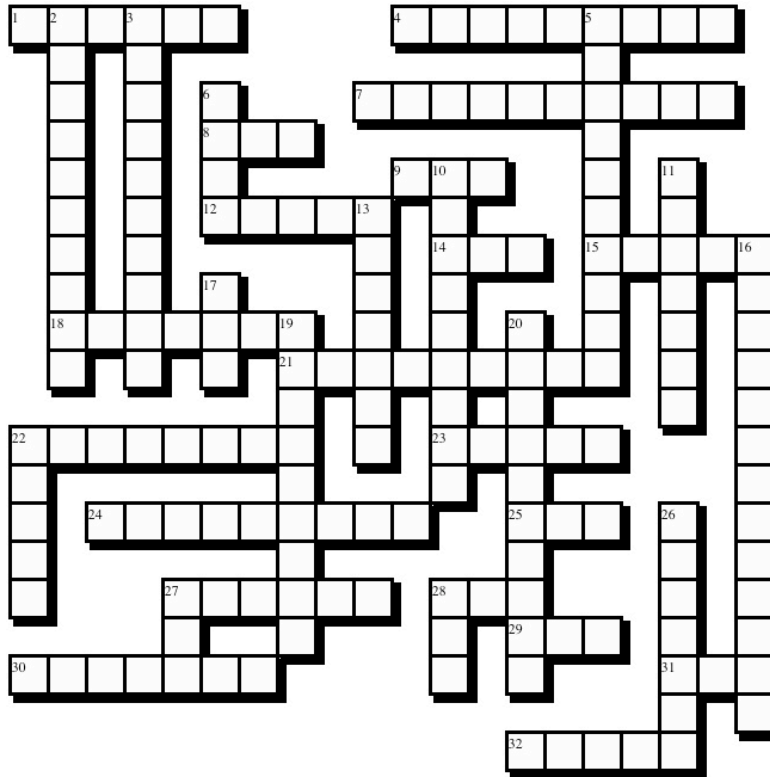


## Usability Legs & Regs Crossword
